How to Use This Guide

Each prayer has two sections: (1) Common After-Salah Adhkar — these 9 adhkar are recited after every prayer. (2) Prayer-Specific Adhkar — additional adhkar uniquely tied to that prayer's time and virtue. After Fajr, the full morning adhkar begin. After Maghrib, the full evening adhkar begin. All hadith numbers follow Sunnah.com standard numbering. Verify with a qualified Islamic scholar before use in publications.

Order of Recitation: After completing the obligatory salah and taslim — (1) Astaghfirullah x3 → (2) Allahumma antas-salam → (3) La ilaha illallah (full) → (4) SubhanAllah 33 + Alhamdulillah 33 + Allahu Akbar 34 → (5) La ilaha illallah (to complete 100) → (6) Ayatul Kursi → (7) 3 Quls → (8) Allahumma a'inni → (9) La ilaha illallah 10x (Fajr & Maghrib) → then prayer-specific additions.

Fajr Prayer

Common After-Salah Adhkar (for all 5 prayers)

1. Astaghfirullah — Seeking Forgiveness 3x

أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ

Transliteration: *Astaghfirullah.*

Translation: I seek forgiveness from Allah.

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever says Astaghfirullah 3 times after each obligatory prayer, his sins will be forgiven even if they were like the foam of the sea.' It is the first act after salah — acknowledging any shortcomings in the prayer itself.

2. Allahumma Antas-Salam — O Allah, You Are Peace 1x

اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ السَّلَامُ وَمِنْكَ السَّلَامُ، تَبَارَكْتَ يَا ذَا الْجَلَالِ وَالْإِكْرَامِ

Transliteration: *Allahumma antas-salamu wa minkas-salam, tabarakta ya Dhal-jalali wal-ikram.*

Translation: O Allah, You are Peace and from You comes peace. Blessed are You, O Possessor of majesty and honor.

✦ **Virtue:** This is the first supplication the Prophet ﷺ made after completing the salah. 'As-Salam' is one of Allah's Beautiful Names. By saying this, the worshipper acknowledges that true peace and security come only from Allah.

3. La ilaha illallah — The Greatest Dhikr 1x

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ، اللَّهُمَّ لَا مَانِعَ لِمَا أَعْطَيْتَ وَلَا مُعْطِي لِمَا مَنَعْتَ وَلَا يَنْفَعُ ذَا الْجَدِّ مِنْكَ الْجَدُّ

Transliteration: *La ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lah, la hul-mulku wa la hul-hamdu wa huwa 'ala kulli shay'in qadir. Allahumma la mani'a lima a'tayta wa la mu'tiya lima mana'ta wa la yanfa'u dhal-jaddi minkal-jadd.*

Translation: There is no god except Allah alone, with no partner. To Him belongs all dominion and all praise and He is over all things powerful. O Allah, none can withhold what You give, and none can give what You withhold, and no wealth or fortune can benefit anyone against You.

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said this after every obligatory prayer. It combines the affirmation of Tawhid with the acknowledgment that all giving and withholding belongs to Allah alone — a perfect declaration of submission after completing salah.

4. Tasbih, Tahmid & Takbir — The Glorification Trio 33 + 33 + 34x

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ (٣٣) اَلْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ (٣٣) اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ (٣٤)

Transliteration: SubhanAllah (33x) — Alhamdulillah (33x) — Allahu Akbar (34x).

Translation: Glory be to Allah (33 times) — All praise is for Allah (33 times) — Allah is the Greatest (34 times).

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever glorifies Allah 33 times, praises Him 33 times, and declares His greatness 34 times after every prayer — that is 100 in total — and then says La ilaha illallah... his sins will be forgiven even if they were like the foam of the sea.' Some narrations say SubhanAllah 33, Alhamdulillah 33, Allahu Akbar 33, and then the full La ilaha illallah to complete 100.

5. Completing 100 — La ilaha illallah after Tasbih 1x

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

Transliteration: La ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lah, lahul-mulku wa lahul-hamdu wa huwa 'ala kulli shay'in qadir.

Translation: There is no god except Allah alone, with no partner. To Him belongs all dominion and all praise, and He is over all things powerful.

♦ **Virtue:** Recited once after the 33 SubhanAllah + 33 Alhamdulillah + 33 Allahu Akbar to complete 100. The Prophet ﷺ said whoever says this after every prayer, his sins will be forgiven even if they are as plentiful as the foam of the sea.

6. Ayatul Kursi — The Verse of the Throne 1x

اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ الْحَيُّ الْقَيُّومُ ۚ لَا تَأْخُذُهُ سِنَّةٌ وَلَا نَوْمٌ ۚ لَهُ مَا فِي السَّمَاوَاتِ وَمَا فِي الْأَرْضِ ۗ مَنْ ذَا الَّذِي يَشْفَعُ عِنْدَهُ إِلَّا بِإِذْنِهِ ۚ يَعْلَمُ مَا بَيْنَ أَيْدِيهِمْ وَمَا خَلْفَهُمْ ۗ وَلَا يُحِيطُونَ بِشَيْءٍ مِّنْ عِلْمِهِ إِلَّا بِمَا شَاءَ ۚ وَسِعَ كُرْسِيُّهُ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضَ ۗ وَلَا يَئُودُهُ حِفْظُهُمَا ۚ وَهُوَ الْعَلِيُّ الْعَظِيمُ

Transliteration: Allahu la ilaha illa Huwal-Hayyul-Qayyum, la ta'khuduhu sinatun wa la nawm, lahu ma fis-samawati wa ma fil-ard, man dhal-ladhi yashfa'u 'indahu illa bi-idhnih, ya'lamu ma bayna aydihim wa ma khalfahum, wa la yuhituna bi shay'im min 'ilmih illa bima sha', wasi'a kursiyuhus-samawati wal-ard, wa la ya'uduhu hizuhuma wa Huwal-'Aliyyul-'Azim.

Translation: Allah — there is no deity except Him, the Ever-Living, the Sustainer of existence. Neither drowsiness overtakes Him nor sleep. To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth. Who is it that can intercede with Him except by His permission? He knows what is before them and what will be after them, and they encompass not a thing of His knowledge except for what He wills. His Kursi extends over the heavens and the earth, and their preservation tires Him not. And He is the Most High, the Most Great.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever recites Ayatul Kursi after every obligatory prayer, nothing will prevent him from entering Paradise except death.' — One of the greatest virtues attached to any single act of worship.

7. Surah Al-Ikhlās, Al-Falaq, An-Nas 1x each (3x after Fajr & Maghrib)

قُلْ هُوَ اللَّهُ أَحَدٌ ۝ قُلْ أَعُوذُ بِرَبِّ الْفَلَقِ ۝ قُلْ أَعُوذُ بِرَبِّ النَّاسِ

Transliteration: Qul Huwallahu Ahad — Qul A'udhu bi-Rabbil-falaq — Qul A'udhu bi-Rabbin-nas.

Translation: Surah Al-Ikhlās (112) · Surah Al-Falaq (113) · Surah An-Nas (114). Each recited once after every prayer, and three times after Fajr and Maghrib.

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Recite Qul Huwa Allahu Ahad and the Mu'awwidhatayn three times in the morning and evening — they will suffice you against everything.' After Fajr and Maghrib they are read 3x each as morning/evening adhkar begin.

8. Dua for Remembrance, Gratitude & Proper Worship 1x

اللَّهُمَّ أَعِنِّي عَلَى ذِكْرِكَ وَشُكْرِكَ وَحُسْنِ عِبَادَتِكَ

Transliteration: *Allahumma a'inni 'ala dhikrika wa shukrika wa husni 'ibadatik.*

Translation: O Allah, help me to remember You, to be grateful to You, and to worship You in the best manner.

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ took the hand of Mu'adh ibn Jabal (RA) and said: 'O Mu'adh, by Allah I love you, so never forget to say this after every prayer.' It is one of the most beloved post-prayer supplications, blending dhikr, shukr, and perfect 'ibadah.

9. La ilaha illallah — 10 Times (after Fajr & Maghrib) 10x

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ، يُحْيِي وَيُمِيتُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

Transliteration: *La ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lah, lahul-mulku wa lahul-hamdu yuhyi wa yumit, wa huwa 'ala kulli shay'in qadir.*

Translation: There is no god except Allah alone, with no partner. To Him belongs all dominion and all praise. He gives life and causes death and He is over all things powerful.

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever says this 10 times after Fajr and Maghrib will have 10 hasanat written, 10 sayyi'at erased, be raised 10 degrees, be protected from Shaytan all day and night, and no sin will harm him that day except shirk.' This is especially for Fajr and Maghrib.

Additional Adhkar Specific to Fajr

F1. Morning Adhkar Begin — Asbahna 1x

أَصْبَحْنَا وَأَصْبَحَ الْمُلْكُ لِلَّهِ، وَالْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ، لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

Transliteration: *Asbahna wa asbahal-mulku lillah, walhamdu lillah, la ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lah, lahul-mulku wa lahul-hamdu wa huwa 'ala kulli shay'in qadir.*

Translation: We have entered the morning, and at this very time the dominion belongs to Allah. All praise is for Allah. There is no god except Allah alone, with no partner. To Him belongs all dominion and all praise, and He is over all things powerful.

✦ **Virtue:** After Fajr, the full morning adhkar (أذكار الصباح) begin. This is the opening declaration of the morning. All 25 morning adhkar are read after Fajr until sunrise.

F2. Sayyidul Istighfar — Master Forgiveness Supplication 1x

اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ رَبِّي لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ، خَلَقْتَنِي وَأَنَا عَبْدُكَ، وَأَنَا عَلَى عَهْدِكَ وَوَعْدِكَ مَا
اسْتَطَعْتُ، أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا صَنَعْتُ، أَبُوءُ لَكَ بِنِعْمَتِكَ عَلَيَّ وَأَبُوءُ بِذَنْبِي
فَاغْفِرْ لِي فَإِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ الذُّنُوبَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ

Transliteration: *Allahumma anta rabbi la ilaha illa ant, khalaqtani wa ana 'abduk, wa ana 'ala 'ahdika wa wa'dika mastata't, a'udhu bika min sharri ma sana't, abu'u laka bini'matika 'alayya wa abu'u bidhanbi faghfir li fa'innahu la yaghfirudh-dhunuba illa ant.*

Translation: O Allah, You are my Lord. There is no god except You. You created me and I am Your servant. I am upon Your covenant and promise to the best of my ability. I seek refuge in You from the evil of what I have done. I acknowledge Your blessing upon me and I acknowledge my sin. So forgive me, for no one forgives sins but You.

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever says this in the morning with conviction and dies that day before evening enters Paradise.' It is the crown of the morning adhkar after Fajr.

F3. Dua for Beneficial Knowledge, Pure Provision & Accepted Deeds 1x

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ عِلْمًا نَافِعًا، وَرِزْقًا طَيِّبًا، وَعَمَلًا مُتَقَبَّلًا

Transliteration: *Allahumma inni as'aluka 'ilman nafi'an, wa rizqan tayyiban, wa 'amalan mutaqabbala.*

Translation: O Allah, I ask You for beneficial knowledge, pure provision, and accepted deeds.

✦ **Virtue:** This dua is specifically recommended after Fajr prayer. It is a complete morning intention — seeking three pillars: knowledge to guide the day, pure rizq to sustain, and actions that are accepted by Allah.

F4. SubhanAllahi wa Bihamdih — Morning Tasbih 100x

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ

Transliteration: *Subhanallahi wa bihamdih.*

Translation: Glory be to Allah and His is all praise.

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever says SubhanAllahi wa bihamdih 100 times in the morning, his sins will be wiped away even if they are like the foam of the sea.' And: 'No one will come on the Day of Resurrection with better deeds than one who says this 100 times morning and evening.' Best time is after Fajr.

F5. Dua of Sitting after Fajr — Remembering Allah until Sunrise 1x

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ بِأَنَّ لَكَ الْحَمْدَ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ وَحَدَكَ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ، الْمَنَّانُ،
يَا بَدِيعَ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضِ، يَا ذَا الْجَلَالِ وَالْإِكْرَامِ، يَا حَيُّ يَا قَيُّوْمُ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ
الْجَنَّةَ وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ النَّارِ

Transliteration: *Allahumma inni as'aluka bi-anna lakal-hamda la ilaha illa anta wahdaka la sharika lak, al-Mannan, ya Badi'as-samawati wal-ard, ya Dhal-jalali wal-ikram, ya Hayyu ya Qayyum, inni as'alukal-jannah wa a'udhu bika minan-nar.*

Translation: O Allah, I ask You — for to You belongs all praise, there is no god but You alone with no partner — O Most Generous, O Originator of the heavens and earth, O Possessor of majesty and honor, O Ever-Living, O Eternal Sustainer — I ask You for Paradise and I seek refuge in You from the Fire.

◆ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever sits after Fajr prayer remembering Allah until sunrise, then prays two rak'ahs, will have the reward of a complete Hajj and Umrah.' This dua encapsulates that remembrance.

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever says this 10 times after Fajr and Maghrib will have 10 hasanat written, 10 sayyi'at erased, be raised 10 degrees, be protected from Shaytan all day and night, and no sin will harm him that day except shirk.' This is especially for Fajr and Maghrib.

11. Last Two Verses of Surah Al-Baqarah 1x

أَمَّنَ الرَّسُولُ بِمَا أُنزِلَ إِلَيْهِ مِنْ رَبِّهِ وَالْمُؤْمِنُونَ ۚ كُلٌّ آمَنَ بِاللَّهِ وَمَلَائِكَتِهِ وَكُتُبِهِ
وَرُسُلِهِ ۚ وَقَالُوا سَمِعْنَا وَأَطَعْنَا ۚ غُفْرَانَكَ رَبَّنَا وَإِلَيْكَ الْمَصِيرُ ﴿٢٨٦﴾ لَا يُكَلِّفُ اللَّهُ
نَفْسًا إِلَّا وُسْعَهَا ۚ رَبَّنَا لَا تُؤَاخِذْنَا إِنْ نَسِينَا أَوْ أَخْطَأْنَا ۚ رَبَّنَا وَاعْفُ عَنَّا وَاعْفِرْ
لَنَا وَارْحَمْنَا ۚ أَنْتَ مَوْلَانَا فَانصُرْنَا عَلَى الْقَوْمِ الْكَافِرِينَ

Translation: The Messenger has believed in what was revealed to him from his Lord... Allah does not burden a soul beyond that it can bear... (Full verses 2:285-286)

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever recites the last two verses of Surah Al-Baqarah at night, they will suffice him.' Isha is the last prayer of the day — reciting these verses after Isha ensures one sleeps under their protection.

12. Dua before Sleeping — After Isha 1x

بِسْمِكَ اللَّهُمَّ أَمُوتُ وَأَحْيَا

Transliteration: *Bismika Allahumma amutu wa ahya.*

Translation: In Your name, O Allah, I die and I live.

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ would say this when going to sleep after Isha. Sleep is described as a 'minor death' in Islam — this dua of surrender acknowledges that life and death are fully in Allah's hands. It bridges the prayer and rest.

13. Tasbih of Fatimah — Before Sleep 33 + 33 + 34x

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ (٣٣) اَلْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ (٣٣) اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ (٣٤)

Transliteration: *SubhanAllah (33x) — Alhamdulillah (33x) — Allahu Akbar (34x).*

Translation: Glory be to Allah (33x) — All praise is for Allah (33x) — Allah is the Greatest (34x).

✦ **Virtue:** Fatimah (RA) came to the Prophet ﷺ asking for a servant to help with household work. He said: 'Shall I not tell you of something better than that? When you go to your bed, say SubhanAllah 33 times, Alhamdulillah 33 times, and Allahu Akbar 34 times — that is better for you than a servant.' This tasbih after Isha before sleep is a great Sunnah.

14. Dua for Forgiveness of All Sins of the Night 1x

اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّكَ عَفُوٌّ تُحِبُّ الْعَفْوَ فَاعْفُ عَنِّي

Transliteration: *Allahumma innaka 'afuwwun tuhibbul-'afwa fa'fu 'anni.*

Translation: O Allah, You are the Pardoner, You love to pardon, so pardon me.

✦ **Virtue:** Aisha (RA) asked the Prophet ﷺ: 'What should I say on Laylatul Qadr?' He told her to say this dua. Scholars recommend it as a nightly supplication after Isha — especially in the last 10 nights of Ramadan. It is a complete appeal for full forgiveness.

15. Seeking Refuge from the Night's Trials 3x

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الَّذِي لَا يَضُرُّ مَعَ اسْمِهِ شَيْءٌ فِي الْأَرْضِ وَلَا فِي السَّمَاءِ وَهُوَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ

Transliteration: *Bismillahil-ladhi la yadurru ma'asmihi shay'un fil-ardi wa la fis-sama'i wa huwas-Sami'ul-'Alim.*

Translation: In the name of Allah, with whose name nothing on earth or in the heavens can cause harm, and He is the All-Hearing, the All-Knowing.

✦ **Virtue:** After Isha, when the night is fully upon us, this dua provides a seal of protection until morning. Whoever says it 3 times in the evening will not be struck by any calamity before morning — completing the circle of nightly protection.
