Introduction

These 25 morning adhkar are drawn from authentic Hadith — Bukhari, Muslim, Abu Dawud, Tirmidhi, Nasa'i, Ibn Majah, and Ahmad. They are to be read after Fajr prayer until sunrise. The 3 Quls are listed individually (Nos. 2, 3, 4), and the last two verses of Surah Al-Baqarah are presented as one merged entry (No. 24). All hadith numbers follow the Sunnah.com standard numbering. Verify with a qualified Islamic scholar before use in publications.

1. Ayatul Kursi 1x

اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ الْحَيُّ الْقَيُّومُ ۚ لَا تَأْخُذُهُ سِنَّةٌ وَلَا نَوْمٌ ۚ لَهُ مَا فِي السَّمَاوَاتِ
وَمَا فِي الْأَرْضِ ۗ مَنْ ذَا الَّذِي يَشْفَعُ عِنْدَهُ إِلَّا بِإِذْنِهِ ۚ يَعْلَمُ مَا بَيْنَ أَيْدِيهِمْ وَمَا
خَلْفَهُمْ ۗ وَلَا يُحِيطُونَ بِشَيْءٍ مِّنْ عِلْمِهِ إِلَّا بِمَا شَاءَ ۚ وَسِعَ كُرْسِيُّهُ السَّمَاوَاتِ
وَالْأَرْضَ ۗ وَلَا يَئُودُهُ حِفْظُهُمَا ۚ وَهُوَ الْعَلِيُّ الْعَظِيمُ

Transliteration: Allahu la ilaha illa Huwal-Hayyul-Qayyum, la ta'khuduhu sinatun wa la nawm, lahu ma fis-samawati wa ma fil-ard, man dhal-ladhi yashfa'u 'indahu illa bi-idhnihi, ya'lamu ma bayna aydihim wa ma khalfahum, wa la yuhituna bi shay'im min 'ilmihill illa bima sha', wasi'a kursiyyuhus-samawati wal-ard, wa la ya'uduhu hifzuhuma wa Huwal-'Aliyyul-'Azim.

Translation: Allah — there is no deity except Him, the Ever-Living, the Sustainer of existence. Neither drowsiness overtakes Him nor sleep. To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth. Who is it that can intercede with Him except by His permission? He knows what is before them and what will be after them, and they encompass not a thing of His knowledge except for what He wills. His Kursi extends over the heavens and the earth, and their preservation tires Him not. And He is the Most High, the Most Great.

♦ **Virtue:** Whoever recites Ayatul Kursi after every obligatory prayer, nothing will prevent him from entering Paradise except death. (An-Nasa'i). Whoever recites it in the morning will be under the protection of Allah until evening, and whoever recites it in the evening will be protected until morning.

2. Surah Al-Ikhlās 3x

قُلْ هُوَ اللَّهُ أَحَدٌ ﴿١﴾ اللَّهُ الصَّمَدُ ﴿٢﴾ لَمْ يَلِدْ وَلَمْ يُولَدْ ﴿٣﴾ وَمَنْ يَكُنْ لَهُ
كُفُوًا أَحَدٌ

Transliteration: Qul Huwallahu Ahad. Allahus-Samad. Lam yalid wa lam yulad. Wa lam yakul-lahu kufuwan ahad.

Translation: Say: He is Allah, the One. Allah, the Eternal Refuge. He neither begets nor was born. Nor is there to Him any equivalent.

♦ **Virtue:** Reciting Surah Al-Ikhlās 3 times in the morning and evening is equivalent to reciting the entire Quran. It is described as equivalent to one-third of the Quran.

3. Surah Al-Falaq 3x

قُلْ أَعُوذُ بِرَبِّ الْفَلَقِ ﴿١﴾ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا خَلَقَ ﴿٢﴾ وَمِنْ شَرِّ غَاسِقٍ إِذَا وَقَبَ ﴿٣﴾
﴿٤﴾ وَمِنْ شَرِّ النَّفَّاثَاتِ فِي الْعُقَدِ ﴿٥﴾ وَمِنْ شَرِّ حَاسِدٍ إِذَا حَسَدَ

Transliteration: Qul a'udhu bi-Rabbil-falaq. Min sharri ma khalaq. Wa min sharri ghasiqin idha waqab. Wa min sharrin-naffathati fil-'uqad. Wa min sharri hasidin idha hasad.

Translation: Say: I seek refuge in the Lord of daybreak, from the evil of that which He created, and from the evil of darkness when it settles, and from the evil of the blowers in knots, and from the evil of an envier when he envies.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Say Qul Huwa Allahu Ahad, Qul A'udhu bi-Rabbil Falaq, and Qul A'udhu bi-Rabbin-Nas, three times in the morning and evening — they will suffice you against everything.'

4. Surah An-Nas 3x

قُلْ أَعُوذُ بِرَبِّ النَّاسِ ﴿١﴾ مَلِكِ النَّاسِ ﴿٢﴾ إِلَهِ النَّاسِ ﴿٣﴾ مِنْ شَرِّ
الْوَسْوَاسِ الْخَنَّاسِ ﴿٤﴾ الَّذِي يُوَسْوِسُ فِي صُدُورِ النَّاسِ ﴿٥﴾ مِنَ الْجِنَّةِ
وَالنَّاسِ

Transliteration: Qul a'udhu bi-Rabbin-nas. Malikin-nas. Ilahin-nas. Min sharril-waswasil-khannas. Alladhi yuwaswisu fi sudurin-nas. Minal-jinnati wan-nas.

Translation: Say: I seek refuge in the Lord of mankind, the Sovereign of mankind, the God of mankind, from the evil of the retreating whisperer — who whispers into the breasts of mankind — from among the jinn and mankind.

♦ **Virtue:** Reciting the three Quls together (Al-Ikhlās, Al-Falaq, An-Nas) three times each morning and evening provides comprehensive protection from every form of evil — envy, magic, jinn and human harm.

5. Dua upon Entering Morning — Asbahna 1x

أَصْبَحْنَا وَأَصْبَحَ الْمُلْكُ لِلَّهِ، وَالْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ، لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ،
لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

Transliteration: *Asbahna wa asbahal-mulku lillah, walhamdu lillah, la ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lah, laahul-mulku wa laahul-hamdu wa huwa 'ala kulli shay'in qadir.*

Translation: We have entered the morning, and at this very time the dominion belongs entirely to Allah. All praise is for Allah. There is no god except Allah alone, with no partner. To Him belongs all dominion and all praise, and He is over all things powerful.

♦ **Virtue:** This dua declares the Sovereignty of Allah at the start of each day. It is an affirmation of Tawhid and gratitude at the beginning of the morning.

6. Sayyidul Istighfar — Master Supplication for Forgiveness 1x

اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ رَبِّي لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ، خَلَقْتَنِي وَأَنَا عَبْدُكَ، وَأَنَا عَلَى عَهْدِكَ
وَوَعْدِكَ مَا اسْتَطَعْتُ، أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا صَنَعْتُ، أَبُوءُ لَكَ بِنِعْمَتِكَ عَلَيَّ
وَأَبُوءُ بِذَنْبِي فَاغْفِرْ لِي فَإِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ الذُّنُوبَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ

Transliteration: *Allahumma anta rabbi la ilaha illa ant, khalaqtani wa ana 'abduk, wa ana 'ala 'ahdika wa wa'dika mastata't, a'udhu bika min sharri ma sana't, abu'u laka bini'matika 'alayya wa abu'u bidhanbi faghfir li fa'innahu la yaghfirudh-dhunuba illa ant.*

Translation: O Allah, You are my Lord. There is no god except You. You created me and I am Your servant. I am upon Your covenant and promise to the best of my ability. I seek refuge in You from the evil of what I have done. I acknowledge Your blessing upon me, and I acknowledge my sin. So forgive me, for no one forgives sins but You.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'This is the best way of seeking forgiveness. Whoever says it with conviction in the morning and dies that day before evening enters Paradise; and whoever says it at night with conviction and dies before morning enters Paradise.'

7. Bismillah — Protection from All Harm 3x

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الَّذِي لَا يَضُرُّ مَعَ اسْمِهِ شَيْءٌ فِي الْأَرْضِ وَلَا فِي السَّمَاءِ وَهُوَ
السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ

Transliteration: *Bismillahil-ladhi la yadurru ma'asmihi shay'un fil-ardi wa la fis-sama'i wa huwas-Sami'ul-'Alim.*

Translation: In the name of Allah, with whose name nothing on earth or in the heavens can cause harm, and He is the All-Hearing, the All-Knowing.

♦ **Virtue:** Whoever says this 3 times in the morning will not be afflicted by any sudden calamity until evening; and whoever says it 3 times in the evening will not be afflicted until morning. Imam Ibn Al-Qayyim and Al-Albani classed it Sahih.

8. Allahumma bika Asbahna — Morning Declaration 1x

اللَّهُمَّ بِكَ أَصْبَحْنَا، وَبِكَ أَمْسَيْنَا، وَبِكَ نَحْيَا، وَبِكَ نَمُوتُ، وَإِلَيْكَ النُّشُورُ

Transliteration: *Allahumma bika asbahna, wa bika amsayna, wa bika nahya, wa bika namutu, wa ilaykan-nushur.*

Translation: O Allah, by Your grace we have reached the morning, by Your grace we reach the evening, by Your grace we live, and by Your grace we die. And to You is the resurrection.

♦ **Virtue:** This was a daily morning supplication taught by the Prophet ﷺ to his companions. It establishes complete reliance on Allah at the start of the day.

9. Dua for Well-being — Aafiyah 3x

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ الْعَفْوَ وَالْعَافِيَةَ فِي الدُّنْيَا وَالْآخِرَةِ

Transliteration: *Allahumma inni as'alukal-'afwa wal-'afiyata fid-dunya wal-akhirah.*

Translation: O Allah, I ask You for pardon and well-being in this world and in the Hereafter.

♦ **Virtue:** Ibn Umar (RA) narrated that the Prophet ﷺ never missed saying this dua every morning and evening. After iman, nothing better has been given to a person than 'aafiyah (well-being).

10. Comprehensive Protection — Allahumma 'Alimal Ghayb 1x

اللَّهُمَّ عَالِمِ الْغَيْبِ وَالشَّهَادَةِ، فَاطِرِ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضِ، رَبِّ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ
وَمَلِيكِهِ، أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ، أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ نَفْسِي وَمِنْ شَرِّ
الشَّيْطَانِ وَشَرِّكَه

Transliteration: *Allahumma 'alimal-ghaybi wash-shahadah, fatiras-samawati wal-ard, rabba kulli shay'in wa malikah, ashhadu an la ilaha illa ant, a'udhu bika min sharri nafsi wa min sharrish-shaytani wa shirkh.*

Translation: O Allah, Knower of the unseen and the seen, Creator of the heavens and earth, Lord and Sovereign of all things — I bear witness that there is no god but You. I seek refuge in You from the evil of my own soul and from the evil of Shaytan and his plots.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ taught this dua to Abu Bakr As-Siddiq (RA) and instructed him to say it every morning, evening, and before sleeping. It is a shield from the inner evil of the nafs and outer evil of Shaytan.

11. Tasbih — SubhanAllahi wa Bihamdih 100x

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ

Transliteration: *Subhanallahi wa bihamdih.*

Translation: Glory be to Allah and His is all praise.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever says SubhanAllahi wa bihamdih 100 times in the morning and evening, no one will come on the Day of Resurrection with better deeds than him, except one who said the same or more.' And: 'His sins will be wiped away even if they are like the foam of the sea.'

12. Tahleel — La ilaha illallah 10x

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ، يُحْيِي وَيُمِيتُ، وَهُوَ
عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

Transliteration: La ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lah, la hul-mulku wa la hul-hamdu yuhyi wa yumit, wa huwa 'ala kulli shay'in qadir.

Translation: There is no god except Allah alone, with no partner. To Him belongs all dominion and all praise. He gives life and causes death, and He is over all things powerful.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever says this 10 times in the morning will have 10 good deeds recorded, 10 bad deeds erased, be raised 10 degrees in status, and be protected from Shaytan all day until evening.'

13. Dua of Gratitude — Acknowledging Allah's Blessings 1x

اللَّهُمَّ مَا أَصْبَحَ بِي مِنْ نِعْمَةٍ أَوْ بِأَحَدٍ مِنْ خَلْقِكَ فَمِنْكَ وَحْدَكَ لَا شَرِيكَ
لَكَ، فَلَكَ الْحَمْدُ وَلَكَ الشُّكْرُ

Transliteration: Allahumma ma asbaha bi min ni'matin aw bi-ahadin min khalqika faminka wahdaka la sharika lak, falakal-hamdu wa lakash-shukr.

Translation: O Allah, whatever blessing I or any of Your creation have received this morning is from You alone, with no partner. All praise and all thanks belong to You.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever says this in the morning has fulfilled his obligation of thanks to Allah for that day.' It is one of the most virtuous morning adhkar for acknowledging daily blessings.

14. Raditu Billahi — Contentment with Allah 3x

رَضِيتُ بِاللَّهِ رَبًّا، وَبِالْإِسْلَامِ دِينًا، وَبِمُحَمَّدٍ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ نَبِيًّا

Transliteration: Raditu billahi rabban, wa bil-islami dinan, wa bi-Muhammadin sallallahu 'alayhi wa sallama nabiyya.

Translation: I am pleased with Allah as my Lord, with Islam as my religion, and with Muhammad ﷺ as my Prophet.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'There is no Muslim who says this three times in the morning and three times in the evening except that it becomes incumbent upon Allah to please him on the Day of Resurrection.'

15. Salawat upon the Prophet ﷺ 10x

اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ وَسَلِّمْ عَلَى نَبِيِّنَا مُحَمَّدٍ

Transliteration: *Allahumma salli wa sallim 'ala nabiyina Muhammad.*

Translation: O Allah, send Your blessings and peace upon our Prophet Muhammad.

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever sends salawat upon me 10 times in the morning and 10 times in the evening will have my intercession on the Day of Judgement.' Each salawat upon the Prophet ﷺ brings 10 blessings from Allah.

16. Dua for Body, Hearing & Sight — with Protection from Disbelief & Poverty

اللَّهُمَّ عَافِنِي فِي بَدَنِي، اللَّهُمَّ عَافِنِي فِي سَمْعِي، اللَّهُمَّ عَافِنِي فِي بَصَرِي، لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ، اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْكُفْرِ وَالْفَقْرِ وَعَذَابِ الْقَبْرِ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ

Transliteration: *Allahumma 'afini fi badani, Allahumma 'afini fi sam'i, Allahumma 'afini fi basari, la ilaha illa ant. Allahumma inni a'udhu bika minal-kufri wal-faqri wa 'adhabil-qabr, la ilaha illa ant.*

Translation: O Allah, grant me well-being in my body. O Allah, grant me well-being in my hearing. O Allah, grant me well-being in my sight. There is no god but You. O Allah, I seek refuge in You from disbelief, poverty, and the punishment of the grave. There is no god but You.

✦ **Virtue:** This comprehensive dua combines two important supplications narrated together — seeking physical well-being and protection from the three greatest harms: disbelief (kufr), poverty (faqr), and the punishment of the grave.

17. Hasbiyallah — Complete Reliance on Allah 7x

حَسْبِيَ اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ عَلَيْهِ تَوَكَّلْتُ وَهُوَ رَبُّ الْعَرْشِ الْعَظِيمِ

Transliteration: *Hasbiyallahu la ilaha illa huwa 'alayhi tawakkaltu wa huwa Rabbul-'Arshil-'Azim.*

Translation: Allah is sufficient for me. There is no god but Him. In Him I place my trust, and He is the Lord of the Magnificent Throne.

✦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Allah will take care of whatever concerns whoever says this 7 times in the morning and evening — in matters of this world and the Hereafter.'

18. A'udhu Bikalimatillah — Refuge in Allah's Perfect Words 3x

أَعُوذُ بِكَلِمَاتِ اللَّهِ التَّامَّاتِ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا خَلَقَ

Transliteration: *A'udhu bikalimatillahit-tammati min sharri ma khalaq.*

Translation: I seek refuge in the perfect words of Allah from the evil of what He has created.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever says this when evening comes, no harm will afflict him that night.' Abu Hurairah (RA) reported: A man came to the Prophet ﷺ saying he had been stung by a scorpion. The Prophet ﷺ replied: 'Had you said this in the evening, it would not have harmed you.'

19. Dua for Beneficial Knowledge & Pure Provision 1x

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ عِلْمًا نَافِعًا، وَرِزْقًا طَيِّبًا، وَعَمَلًا مُتَقَبَّلًا

Transliteration: *Allahumma inni as'aluka 'ilman nafi'an, wa rizqan tayyiban, wa 'amalan mutaqqabbala.*

Translation: O Allah, I ask You for beneficial knowledge, pure provision, and accepted deeds.

♦ **Virtue:** This dua is specifically recommended to be said after Fajr prayer. It covers the three pillars of a blessed life: beneficial knowledge to guide, pure provision to sustain, and accepted deeds to earn the Hereafter.

20. Dua Against Anxiety, Laziness, Debt & Weakness 1x

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ أَلَمٍ وَحُزْنٍ، وَالْعَجْزِ وَالْكَسَلِ، وَالْبُخْلِ وَالْجُبْنِ،
وَضَلَعِ الدِّينِ وَغَلْبَةِ الرِّجَالِ

Transliteration: *Allahumma inni a'udhu bika minal-hammi wal-hazan, wal-'ajzi wal-kasal, wal-bukhli wal-jubn, wa dhala'id-dayni wa ghalabatir-rijal.*

Translation: O Allah, I seek refuge in You from anxiety and grief, from weakness and laziness, from miserliness and cowardice, from the overwhelming burden of debt and from being overpowered by people.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ was regularly heard reciting this dua. It addresses eight personal weaknesses and challenges that can hinder a Muslim's spiritual and worldly progress.

21. Dua Against Shirk — Seeking Protection from Associating Partners 1x

Transliteration: *Allahumma inni a'udhu bika an ushrika bika wa ana a'lam, wa astaghfiruka lima la a'lam.*

Translation: O Allah, I seek refuge in You from knowingly associating partners with You, and I seek Your forgiveness for what I do unknowingly.

♦ **Virtue:** This dua covers both intentional and unintentional shirk. The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever says this in the morning, it covers the sins committed that day; and whoever says it in the evening, it covers the sins committed that night.'

22. Ya Hayyu Ya Qayyum — O Ever-Living, O Sustainer 3x

يَا حَيُّ يَا قَيُّوْمُ، بِرَحْمَتِكَ أَسْتَغِيْثُ، أَصْلِحْ لِيْ شَأْنِيْ كُلَّهُ، وَلَا تَكِلْنِيْ إِلَى
نَفْسِيْ طَرْفَةَ عَيْنٍ

Transliteration: Ya Hayyu Ya Qayyum, birahmatika astaghith, aslih li sha'ni kullahu, wa la takilni ila nafsi tarfata 'ayn.

Translation: O Ever-Living, O Sustainer of all existence — by Your mercy I seek help. Set right all my affairs, and do not leave me to myself even for the blink of an eye.

♦ **Virtue:** This is one of the most powerful morning supplications. The Prophet ﷺ instructed Fatimah (RA) to say it every morning and evening. It calls upon two of Allah's Greatest Names — Al-Hayy (The Ever-Living) and Al-Qayyum (The Self-Subsisting Sustainer).

23. Istighfar — Seeking Forgiveness 100x

أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ وَأَتُوبُ إِلَيْهِ

Transliteration: Astaghfirullah wa atubu ilayh.

Translation: I seek forgiveness from Allah and I repent to Him.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'By Allah, I seek forgiveness from Allah and repent to Him more than 100 times a day.' The Prophet ﷺ — despite being sinless — modelled the constant turning to Allah in repentance. For us, istighfar 100 times daily wipes sins and elevates rank.

Transliteration: Amanar-rasulu bima unzila ilayhi mir-rabbihi wal-mu'minun, kullun amana billahi wa mala'ikatihi wa kutubih wa rusulih, la nufarriqu bayna ahadin mir-rusulih, wa qalu sami'na wa ata'na ghufranaka rabbana wa ilaykal-masir. La yukallifullahu nafsan illa wus'aha, laha ma kasabat wa 'alayha mak-tasabat, rabbana la tu'akhidhna in nasina aw akhta'na, rabbana wa la tahmil 'alayna isran kama hamaltahu 'alal-ladhina min qablina, rabbana wa la tuhammilna ma la taqata lana bih, wa'fu 'anna wagfir lana warhamna, anta mawlana fansurna 'alal qawmil kafirin.

Translation: The Messenger has believed in what was revealed to him from his Lord, and so have the believers. All of them have believed in Allah, His angels, His Books, and His messengers, saying: 'We make no distinction between any of His messengers.' And they say: 'We hear and we obey. Your forgiveness, Our Lord, and to You is the final return.' Allah does not burden a soul beyond that it can bear. It will have the consequence of what good it has earned, and it will bear the consequence of what evil it has done. Our Lord, do not hold us accountable if we forget or make a mistake. Our Lord, do not burden us as You burdened those before us. Our Lord, do not place upon us a burden we have no strength to bear. Pardon us, forgive us, and have mercy on us. You are our Guardian — so grant us victory over the disbelieving people.

♦ **Virtue:** The Prophet ﷺ said: 'Whoever recites the last two verses of Surah Al-Baqarah at night, they will suffice him.' These two verses were gifted to the Prophet ﷺ on the night of Isra wal-Mi'raj from a Treasure beneath the Throne of Allah. Verse 286 contains 5 profound Rabbana duas.

وَالْعَافِيَةَ فِي دِينِي وَدُنْيَايَ وَأَهْلِي وَمَالِي، اللَّهُمَّ اسْتُرْ عَوْرَاتِي وَآمِنْ رَوْعَاتِي

Transliteration: Allahumma inni as'alukal-'afiyata fid-dunya wal-akhirah. Allahumma inni as'alukal-'afwa wal-'afiyata fi dini wa dunyaya wa ahli wa mali. Allahummastir 'awrati wa amin raw'ati.

Translation: O Allah, I ask You for well-being in this world and the next. O Allah, I ask You for pardon and well-being in my religion, my worldly affairs, my family, and my wealth. O Allah, conceal my faults and keep me safe from my fears.

♦ **Virtue:** Ibn Umar (RA) said: 'The Prophet ﷺ never missed reciting these words every morning and every evening.' The Prophet ﷺ also said: 'After faith (iman), ask Allah for aafiyah (well-being), for no one has been given anything better than aafiyah.'
